1. Go to the link below and install the latest version of Installer

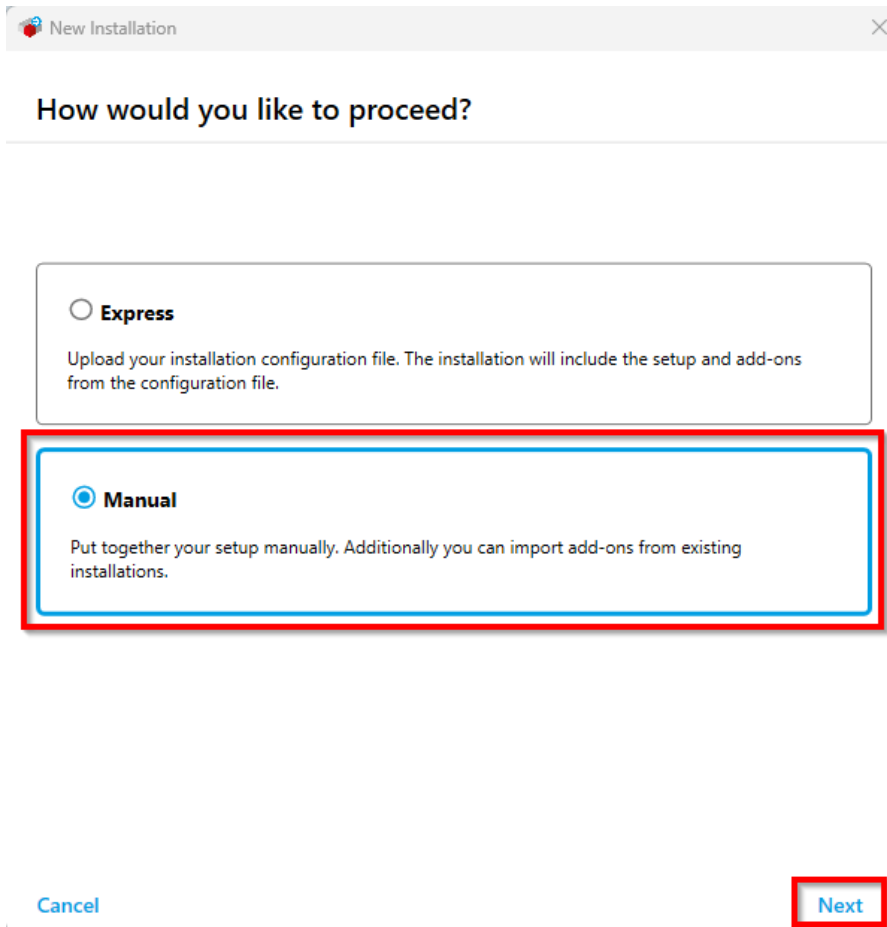
Click on 'Versions' and select the latest one available.

2. Once downloaded, run the 'Codesys Installer' as an administrator



3. Select the 'Manual' option and click 'Next'.





4. Select the setup and version from the drop down menu.
NOTE: Make sure you download the SP19 Patch7 version instead of the latest one.

Toggle the 'Create Separate Repositories' button and click next.

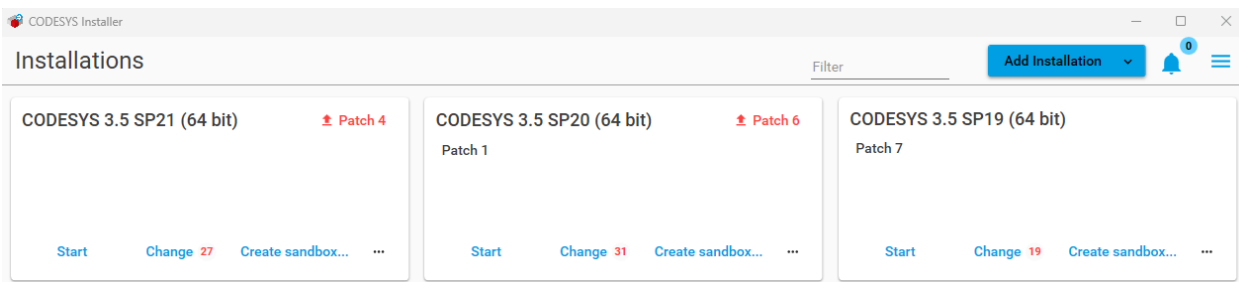
